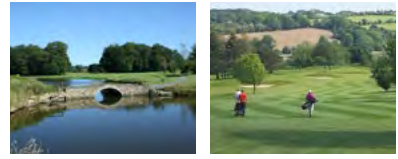
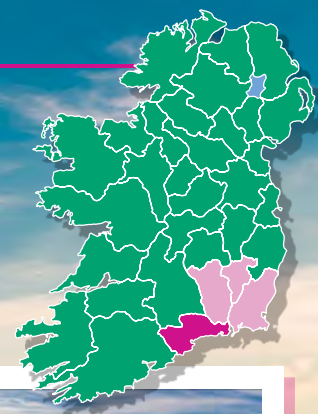
Carlow Golf Club Carlow

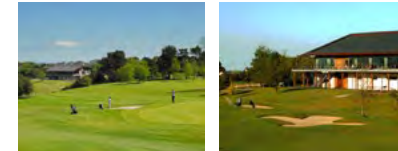
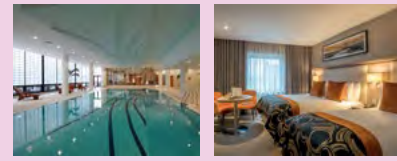
St. Helen's Bay Golf Resort Wexford

Powerscourt Golf Club (East) *Wicklow*

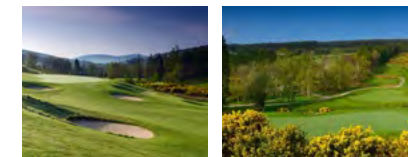

It is no wonder that Powerscourt West course was a past recipient of the "Best Overall Parkland Venue" award.



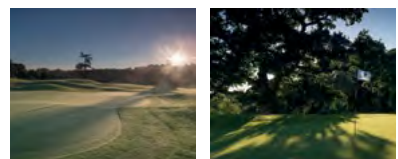
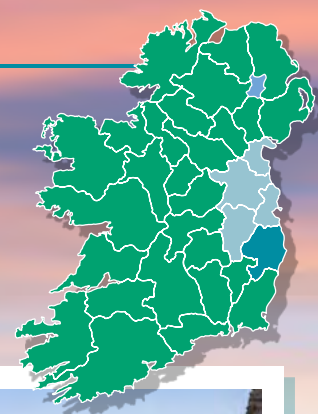
Macreddin Golf Course *Wicklow*

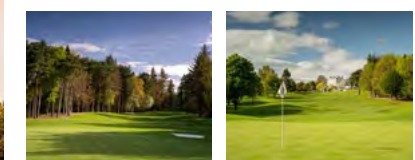
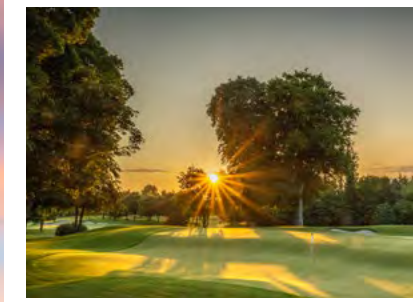


Wicklow Golf Club
