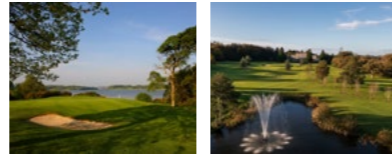
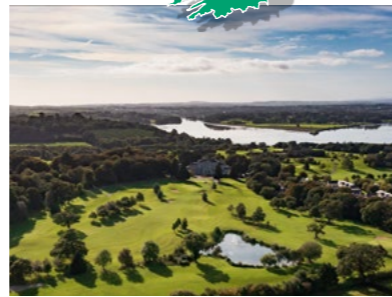
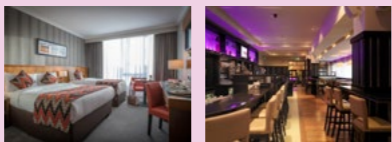
Waterford Castle Golf Club Waterford

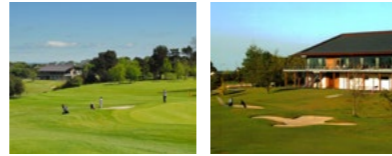
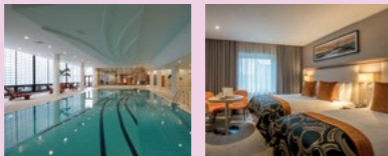
St. Helen's Bay Golf Club Wexford

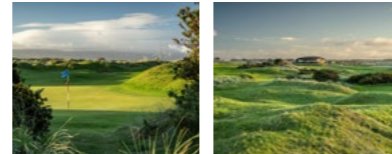
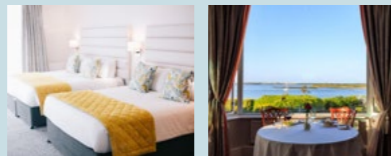
The Royal Dublin Golf Club Dublin
