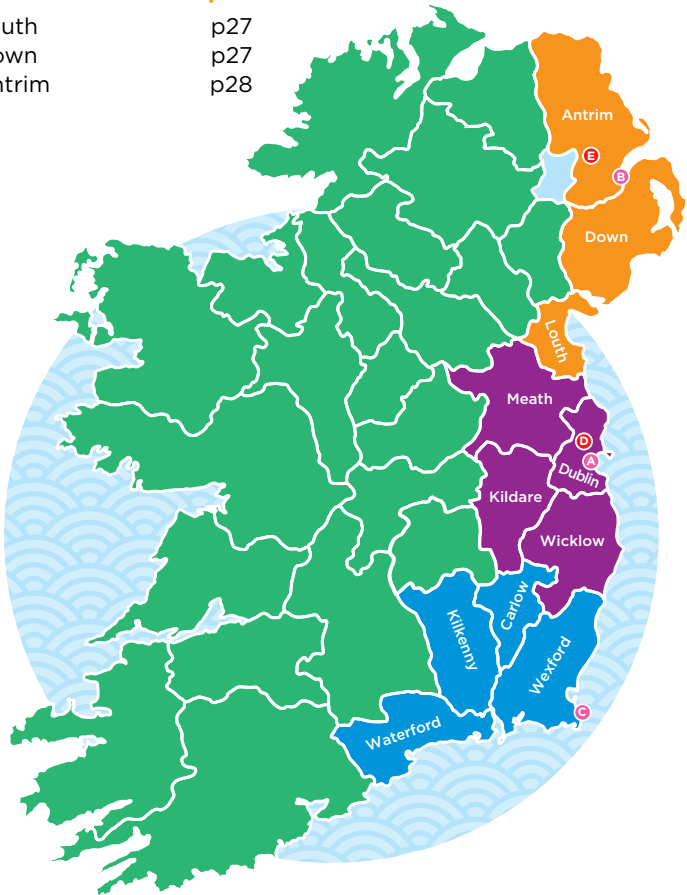
Like Club Choice Ireland, I have ambitious plans for 2018 and beyond. I really hope that you can make it to Ireland this year to experience just some of them.

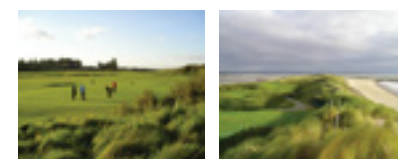
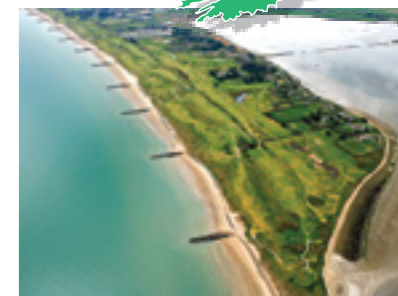
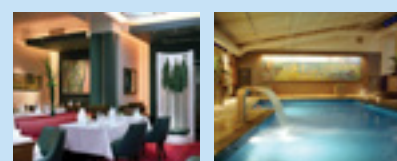
St. Helen's Bay Golf Club Wexford

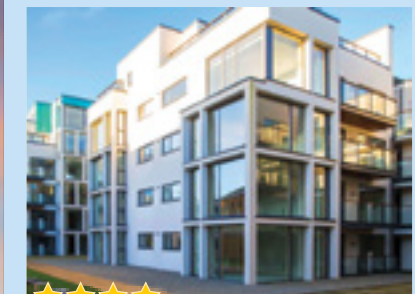

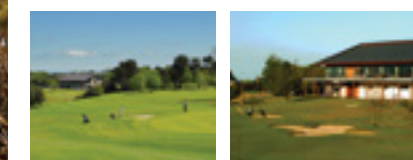
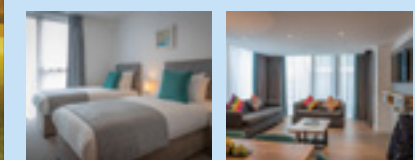
Rosslare Golf Club Wexford

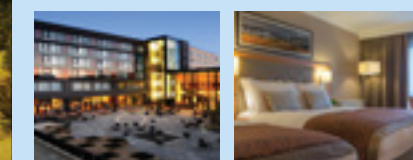
Wexford Golf Club Wexford

Tramore Golf Club *Waterford*

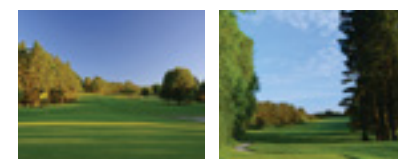
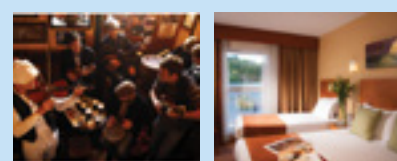

It became established as one of the country's premier parkland courses and has played host to the Irish Close Championship on 3 occasions. The club is renowned for its hospitality to visitors.



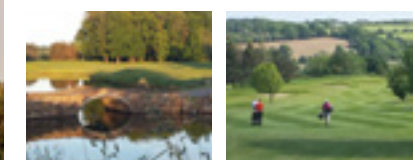
Treacy's Hotel Waterford *Waterford*

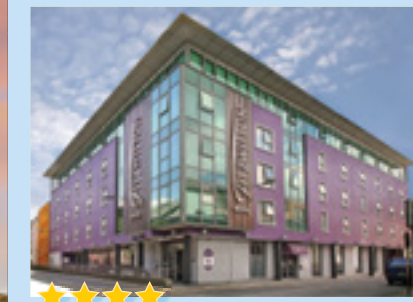
Waterford Golf Club *Waterford*

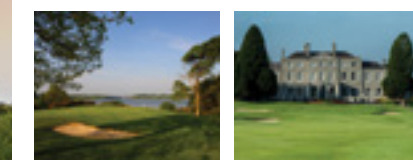
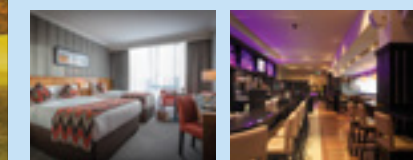
Waterford Castle Golf Club *Waterford*

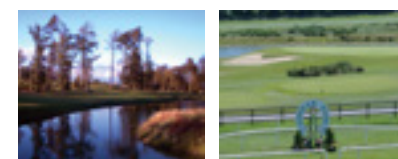
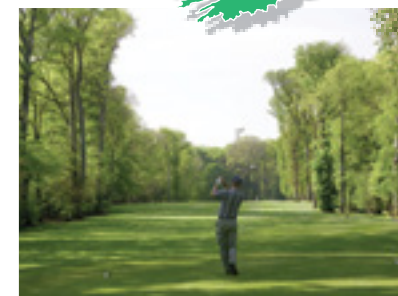
Kilkenny Golf Club *Kilkenny*

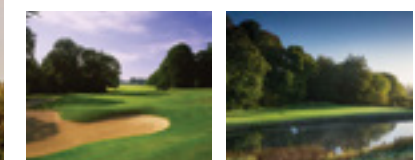
Hotel Kilkenney *Kilkenny*

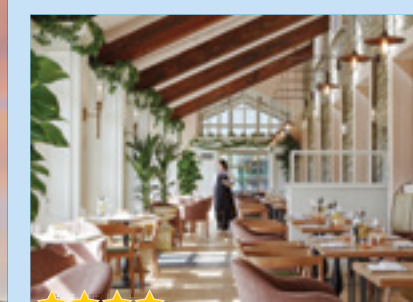
Gowran Park Golf Club *Kilkenny*

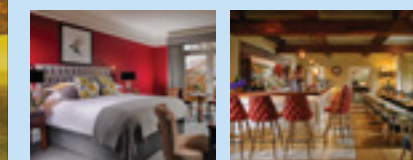
Mount Juliet Golf Club *Kilkenny*

Woodenbridge Golf Club *Wicklow*

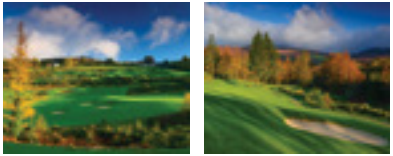
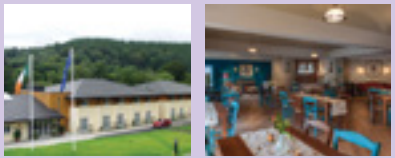

The current 18 hole layout was created in 1994 when the pre-existing 9 hole course – dating back to the 1890’s – was extended. Seamlessly blending tradition and modern design, the course incorporates the flows of the Avoca and the Aughrim rivers, which come into play on ten of the holes. This makes Woodenbridge one of the most scenic courses you can play on in Ireland.
